



This is a drawing someone made up for Hello, Sun. How many different things can you find wrong with this drawing?

Then draw the shadow cast by the house or tree in the sunlight.















Make this shadow appear below by using the shapes in front of you and a flashlight. How many shapes can make this shadow? Why is this so? What is wrong with this picture? Why?






